Other victims:

1) 2001 Douglas County, Nebraska

Jane Doe was raped in her home by David Taitte, hired as a delivery driver by TK Pizza (a franchisee of Domino Pizza) in Nebraska. When he applied for the job he had been in prison 16 times and had a history of sexual assault. He is now serving 25-30 years. **No background check.**

2) 2000 Alamo, California

Dr. Kim Fang, a plastic surgeon, was murdered by ex-convict Mesa Kasem (and an accomplice) while working as a delivery man for an auction house. Kasem's first conviction – for firearms offences – was when he was 17. He was also a gang member. **No background check.**

3) 1999 Norcross, Georgia

Melissa Danielle Jennings was murdered by the apartment complex maintenance man, Calvin Oliver, a convicted rapist. His criminal record, spanning almost 20 years, also included armed robbery, burglary, robbery by force, credit card fraud and, at the time that he was hired by TGM Ashley Lakes Inc., there was an outstanding warrant for his arrest on theft check charges. He was jailed for life for murder. **No background check.**

4) 1999 Kansas City, Missouri

Mary Ruth Bales, an 80 year-old woman was beaten to death in her home by Wesley Purkey, an ex-convict, while working as a plumber. He had spent the last 25 years in prison for various violent felonies including aggravated robbery, burglary, assault and kidnapping. **No background check.**

5) 1998 Alameda, California

Dr. Kerry Spooner-Dean, pediatrician, was robbed and stabbed to death by Jerrol Woods, who worked for America's Best Carpet Care. At the time of his hiring Woods was on parole following a 12-year prison sentence for armed robbery. He had multiple robbery convictions dating back more than 30 years, He was jailed for life without parole. **No background check.**

6) 1996 Alameda, California

Terina Ferminick, a minister's wife, was raped and stabbed to death in her home by carpet cleaner, Giles Nadey. He had two previous felony convictions. **No background check.**

7) 1996 Texas

Jane Doe 4. Kirby Co., a vacuum cleaner manufacturer found liable as one its distributors hired a door to door salesperson with a criminal record who raped a female customer in her home. **No background check.**

Other victims:

8) 1995, Dallas County, Texas

Hall Fin Group found liable after a female tenant was killed by the brother of an apartment complex's assistant manager. The assistant manager had a criminal record. **No background check.**

9) 1994, Florida

Two students murdered by employee of Rainbow International Carpet Drying and Cleaning Co., while cleaning a carpet in their home. Employee had prior arrest for drugs, carrying a concealed weapon and resisting arrest with violence. **No background check.**

10) 1993 Maryland

Jane Doe 3 was sexually assaulted in her home by Arthur Von Lanier who had a long criminal record when he started cleaning carpets for Sears. **No background check.**

11) 1993

Kristi Reade sued the Kirby Company which makes vacuum cleaners, after a salesman sexually assaulted her in her home. He was on probation at the time for indecency with a child. He was hired by an independent distributor. **No background check.**

12) & 13) 1991 Boston, Massachusetts

Alba Pellegrini and John Ward. This 77 year-old grandmother and her 32 year-old quadriplegic grandson were murdered by Jesse Rogers was hired as a home health care aide by Trusted Health Resources. When hire, he had six larceny-related convictions. He had been stealing from Ward and murdered both to cover up the thefts. **No background check.**

14) Pennsylvania

Jane Doe 2 was raped in her home by convicted felon John Cramer, was working as a meter reader. **No background check.**

15) Tallahassee, Florida

Elizabeth Harris was violently attacked by delivery man employed by Tallahassee Furniture. He was a convicted criminal and had a history of mental illness. **No background check.**
